SUBJECT: LICENSES EXPIRING JULY 31, 2020

Due to the unforeseen circumstances in which we have found ourselves due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Division has decided to waive the first year late renewal fees for any UCC license or certification with an expiration date of July 31, 2020, effectively granting a 1-year grace period in which to meet their continuing education requirements and retroactively renew said license.

Accordingly, anyone on your staff or a prospective employee that expired on July 31, 2020 may continue to (or be hired to) fulfill their duties under the Uniform Construction Code. Further, any special inspector that provides a certification to your office with a July 31, 2020 expiration date should be accepted, subject to any other requirements that may be in place for a given project.

We will continue with online, remote continuing education seminars for the fall 2020 semester and it is encouraged that anyone finding themselves in this situation avail themselves of this educational opportunity to meet their requirements and renew as soon as possible. The schedule for the fall is still in development and should be released some time in the next few weeks at most.
